CSSC is going electronic!

CSSC is going electronic! We have recently changed our healthcare records to Electronic Medical Assistant (EMA). Our office encourages every patient to take part in this as well by using the patient portal.

The portal can be very beneficial to you. You are able to update your personal information, medical history, view labs, access pathology reports, contact the office with non-emergency questions and even view your visit notes within one business day following your appointment!

Access to the portal will reduce both the wait time and the cost for medical record release or completion of a cancer policy. For appointments after May 1, 2014, you can obtain those records online, while appointments before May 1, 2014 will need to be requested via fax or mail. Please call the office if you have questions. 704-295-0000.

The patient portal can be accessed in two different ways.

- Our website (<u>www.carolinaskinsurgery.com</u>, scroll to the bottom of the page, click on "Patient Click Here to Log In" this will navigate you to EMA Dermatology/patient portal)
- EMA Dermatology App available for any tablet that supports Microsoft (Surface, Samsung, etc. must be able to download Firefox)

Once you have logged onto the portal, we advise that you review the following information to ensure it has been entered correctly:

Contact Info:

Spelling of your first and last name
Date of birth
Sex
Language
Race

Ethnic Group

Insurance and Pharmacy:

Primary (and secondary) insurance is up-to-date Correct policy number/member ID is correct Pharmacy you like to use

Medications:

You can delete, add and change the dose to your medications at any time.

To add a medication: beside "Drug Name" you will start typing in the name of the medication. If you are having problems entering in the medication, please send the list via the portal intramail (see below for instructions).

If you are not taking any medications, please hit the "Mark No Medications" button.

***It is important that you enter in ALL medications, including vitamins and over-the-counter medications. We ask that you bring a copy of your current medication list to your appointment as well.

Allergies:

If you have any allergies (medications, latex, adhesive, etc.), please be sure that they are all listed. These can also be edited at any time or even deleted. Once your allergy has been entered, it is important for us to know the type of reaction that you have. If you do not see your option listed, please check the "other" box and manually type in your reaction.

If you have no allergies, please hit the "Mark No Known Allergies" button.

If you are having problems entering in the allergy, please send the list via the portal intramail (see below for instructions).

Past Medical History:

It is important to list ALL current medical conditions as well as past surgeries.

If you check any box claiming that you have had a surgery, a text box will show up. It is important to know what year the surgery was performed. If you have a pacemaker or defibrillator, please check the "other" box under past surgeries and manually type this in.

Social History:

We need to know your smoking status. Please choose from one of the following in the drop box:

Current every day smoker

Former smoker

Never smoker

****If you are a smoker, it is important to try to quit for your overall health but at a minimum we ask you to try to **stop smoking** 2 weeks prior to your surgery and 3 weeks after the surgery, because smoking can cause the wound to heal poorly.

Visit notes, lab results and pathology reports:

If you have had an appointment with Dr. Carruth or Lisa Matuga, PA-C since May 1st, 2014, your records may be available on the portal. To access these you will click the "Visit Info" tab at the top of the portal. To view the visit notes, you will need to be on the "My Health" tab located on the left side of the screen.

To view any pathology or culture results, you will need to click the "Test and Results" tab, also on the left side of the screen.

Please note that it may take up to 2 weeks for biopsy results to become available. If the results are not available after 2 weeks and we have not contacted you, please call our office at 704-295-0000.

Contact Us:

For your convenience, we encourage our patients to use the intramail system on the portal. To do so, click the "Contact Us" tab in the top, left corner. If you have any new messages from us, it will automatically show up in your inbox on this screen in bold, blue lettering.

Our office will contact you using intramail the day after any surgical procedure. Please respond to our message to let us know that you are doing okay.

To send us a message, you will click the "New Message" tab. You will then need to select who you would like to send your message to. You can choose more than one person for this.

- For billing/insurance questions: Cathy
- Non-surgical appointments: Sandy
- Surgery appointments: Ashley and Chiffon
- Non-emergency questions for medical assistants: Ashley, Cynthia, Tara and Jackie

Please note that any messages sent via intramail will only be seen by the staff from 7:30 AM - 4:00 PM Monday-Thursday and 8:00 AM - 12:00 PM on Friday.


